This inner reflection equips people for living out the paradox of contemplation in action. At the heart of the Movement is the Christian contemplative tradition.

Since its inception in 1992, The Quiet Garden Movement has become an international network with over 300 Quiet Gardens. They are in rural and urban areas and comprise a variety of locations from private homes and gardens to organisations such as schools and prisons.

Recognising the interconnectedness of all things, the Movement seeks to collaborate with those working in areas of creation care, urban deprivation or in retreat centres.
